THE DISCOVERIES OF GOLD

Montreal, July, 26.—Isolated re-
ports of the finding of gold in the
district north of Lake Temiskaming
continue to be made to L. O.
Armstrong, of the head of the tour
ists and colonization department
of the C. Q. R. The latest find of
this precious metal was reported
on Monday, when the news came
that it had been discovered at
Sandy Bay Inlet, on Lake Temis-
kaming. Of course, with so many
prospectors in the field, following
on the 'strike' of Messrs. Renaud
and Ollier, rumors of all kinds will
be floating around. It may turn
out that the gold is not so plenti-
ful as the specimens brought in
would lead one to believe. If that
should be so, the prospecting fever
will have served a useful end in
drawing attention to the rich de-
posits of base metals which exist
in the district, and which are con-
stantly being struck by the pros-
pectors in the field.

Mr. Armstrong, who knows the
district well, has the greatest con-
fidence in the ultimate development
of these deposits. "We shall have
the most wonderful metal works
in the world in Canada in times to
come," he said, "because of the in-
calculable amount of water power
stretching right across the contin-
ent through the mineral belt. In
addition to using this water for
power, it will be used for electric
smelting. We must also remember
that there will also be a vast
amount of cheap labor looking for
work from November till April
every year. These people will be
engaged on the farms in summer,
but will be glad to work in the
metal factories in the winter. There
is no country so favorably situat-
ed in this respect as Canada.

THE DREADNOUGHT

COST \$8,987,485.

Britain's Latest Battle Ship to
Have Enormous Armament,
and Turbines

London, July 25.—The official an-
nouncement respecting the battle
ship Dreadnought is contained in a
White Book on the naval construc-
tion the last year which was issued
last night. Besides the 12-inch
quick firing anti-torpedo tubes, in
the arrangement of armament six
pairs of the big guns are mounted in
pairs on the centre line of the bat-
tle-ship and the remaining pairs
are mounted in pairs as broad-
sides.

These eight 12-inch guns, or eight-
ty per cent. of the plain armament
can be fired on either broadside,
and four and possibly six 12-inch
guns or 60 p. c. can be fired sim-
ultaneously ahead or astern. In
view of the modern possibilities
of torpedo boats and considering
especially the chances of the tor-
pedo attack toward the end of a
battle, the anti-torpedo boat guns
are widely separated, so that the
whole of them cannot be disabled
by some heavy shell. Special at-
tention has been paid to protection
from submarine explosions.

After thorough consideration
from every point of view, the
White Book states, experts had no
difficulty in arriving at a decision
to adopt turbines, which are con-
sidered more advantageous for
steering speed, providing sufficient
stopping and turning power, and
for purposes of quick and easy
manoeuvring. The speed is design-
ed to be twenty-one knots. The
bunker capacity is 2,700 tons,
with which the Dreadnought can
steam 8,800 sea miles at economi-
cal speed and 3,500 miles at eight-
teen and a half knots. The esti-
mated cost of the Dreadnought, in-
cluding guns, is \$8,987,485.

GREAT DEMAND

FOR HARVESTERS

IN THE WEST.

At Least 25,000 Outsiders Will be
Needed, and Cutting is Likely
to Begin Aug. 10

Winnipeg, Man., July 24.—Mani-
toba and the west will require

from twenty to twenty-five thou-
sand imported harvesters to hand-
le the crop this year," said W. J.
Black, deputy minister of agricul-
ture.

Official reports from all parts of
the province indicate that the crop
will be the heaviest yet harvested.

Last year Manitoba placed 12,000
men from the east in the harvest
fields, while Saskatchewan used
about 3,000, but for this year Mani-
toba alone will require close to
25,000.

It would appear at present that
harvesting will be general through-
out the province about August 10,
but should the rain continue it will
probably be from three to five
days later.
