Surplus of Apples

From Australia estimated at 2,250,000 cases.

Ottawa, Jan. 25.—Canadian Trade Commissioner Ross, writing to the Weekly Bulletin, of the Department of Trade and Commerce, states that the exportable surplus of apples from Australia this season is estimated at 2,250,000 cases. He added that transportation facilities are doubtful. The apple season in Australia commences in February and continues to the end of April.

Purser—Bro. Gwilym Hiscock, elected.


Rec. Sec.—Bro. Ernest Laing, re-elected.
