Mobile, Sept. 1st—The yearly cotton statement shows the total receipts for the year just closed to be 361,093; exports to Great Britain, 215,114; France, 10,432; other foreign ports, 14,292; coastwise, in-cluding 18,659 from Montgomery direct to New Orleans, 130,893 bales. The crop is estimated at two and a quarter millions. New York, Sept. 1—The cattle disease excitement has subsided. The authori-ties consider that the danger is now over and Dr. Howard, the State Commissioner, reports that no infected cattle are in the city or expected to arrive as long as the present rigid surveillance is kept up. The *Tribune's* special says Secretary Seward, who has been in correspondence for some time in relation to matters con-nected with the new reciprocity treaty with Canada, has been informed by the Canadian authorities that the Hon.
