## EDWARDS RAPS ACCUSATIONS OF BISHOP FALLON

Claims He Did Not Select Statistics From "Best Rural Schools."

CITES FRONTENAC DATA

Asserts Legislative Grants Were Much Less Than Teachers' Salaries.

CATARAQUI, Ont., March 6.—Replying to the statements of Bishop M. F. Fallon, of the Roman Catholic diocese of London, relative to the separate schools tax issue, which was published in The London Advertiser recently, Hon. Dr. J. W. Edwards of Frontenac issued a reply here tonight.

Dr. Edwards contends that Bishop Fallon has furnished "elaborate details" to prove a matter that, in his opinion, did not require proof. His statement follows:

"His lordship the Bishop of London charges me with 'scattering meaningless statistics' and with the almost equally grave offense of not reading carefully published reports of his addresses on the separate school question.

"His lordship has not, however, challenged the correctness of my figures and has given further evidence of his appreciation of their value by avoiding the real issue which they clearly suggest and by presenting an elaborate defense where there has been no attack.

"His lordship has gone into elaborate details to prove that which required no proof, namely, that the legislative grant must be divided between the public school system and the separate school system on the basis of average attendance of pupils.

"That was also the basis of division between 1907 and 1917, when, his lordship declares, \$100,000 was diverted from the separate schools (presumably to the public schools), and when, he says, some person acted as an 'educational czar' and 'common thief'.

"In regard to the subsequent distribution of the legislative grant made by regulation to the individual public and separate schools, and to which my statistics applied, Bishop Fallon dismisses the matter by intimating that if the whole amount went to one separate school it is no concern to the general public.

"With that view I venture to suggest his lordship will find few to agree.

"His lordship says I have emphasized the grants earned by and paid to the best rural separate schools, and that while certain schools receive fair-sized grants there are others where the grants are small and insufficient.

"I have not selected the best rural schools in furnishing statistics and making comparisons, and I would be showing scant respect for his lordship's intelligent comprehension of plain facts if I accepted his remark at its face value.

"My comparative figures for Middlesex and Frontenac counties embraced all the public and separate schools. I pointed out that the three separate schools in the township of Glenelg in the county of Grey, with 39 pupils, received \$89 more of a legislative grant than the nine public schools in that township with 143 pupils.

"I pointed out that the same state of affairs existed in the county of Huron and the county of Perth. I directed attention to the fact that the three separate schools on Howe Island received in the last two years enough in government grants to pay their teachers and leave them a bonus of over \$1,250 and that one of these Howe Island separate schools with an attendance of 13 pupils received a larger grant than all the six Protestant separate schools of Ontario, with 12 teachers and 314 pupils.

"These statistics his lordship characterizes as 'meaningless.' Yet while Roman Catholic separate schools are thus being fed to repletion with legislative grants, his lordship asks for a larger share of company and corporation taxes for urban schools.

His lordship says I have avoided referring to two schools in Frontenac to which he has directed attention. He says: 'At Bedford there is a public school with one teacher and one pupil. The legislative grant to that school is larger than the teacher's annual salary. In another public school there are two pupils. There again the legislative grant is larger than the teacher's salary.'

"The public school inspector has furnished me with the following facts regarding these two schools. The Bedford school was closed in 1920 during May, June, July, August and September; number of pupils enrolled 5; average attendance 2; teacher's salary \$600; legislative grant \$171.15. In 1921 the enrollment was 5; average attendance 2.4; teacher's salary \$600 and legislative grant \$344. In regard to the other school referred to the enrollment in 1920 and 1921 was 4, the average attendance in 1920 was 3 and in 1921 was 2, the teacher's salary was \$750 and the legislative grant was \$423.85 in 1920 and \$422.50 in 1921.

"I will make no comment on these figures further than to quote his lordship's admission to myself, merely substituting his name where he used mine.

"It may be that Bishop Fallon has been hitherto unaware of the facts I have herein set forth, but hereafter he will have no justification for repeating misleading figures. In any event such methods will not disturb the supporters of public schools."

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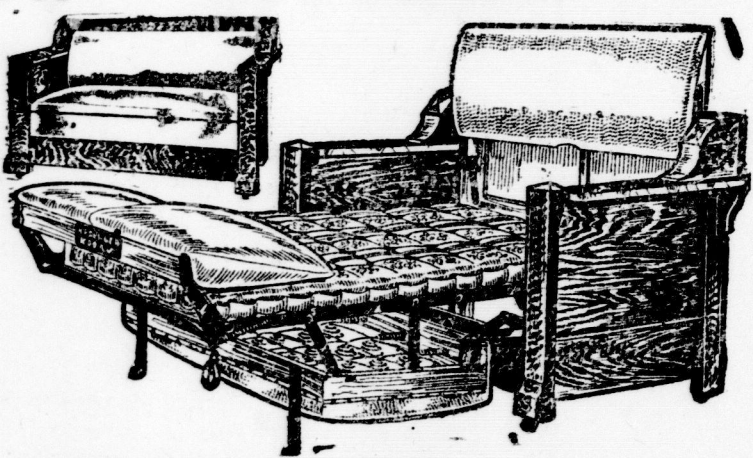
