THE U. S. COTTON CROP.

The statistics of the cotton crop for the season of 1857-1838 fluve now been officially compiled by the New York Cotton Exchange and given to the public. The outturn equalled 7.046,833 bales, and the largest over grown in America, being over 54,000 bales larger than the preceding year, and nearly 100,000 bales in excess of the largest one hitherto recorded, that of 182-1833. The average weight is about 3‡ nounds heavier than last year.


