Important to Country Merchants

E cannot too strongly advise our customers in country that it is in their interest to use only Tubs (either wire or wooden hoop) in shipping their Dairy Butter to market; and farmers should be asked to put up their Butter in tubs only. In the course of a year, we get a large quantity of Dairy Butter put up in boxes and Butter put up in this way, in most cases, has to be sold at a reduced price, on account of boxes breaking easily and separating at corners. The air gets in at butter and, to a large extent, destroys the flavor and, in many ways, injures the quality. The expense is large in putting these packages in proper shipping shape to go on the market. Butter boxes were made to put up Creamery Butter only and not intended for Dairy Butter.
