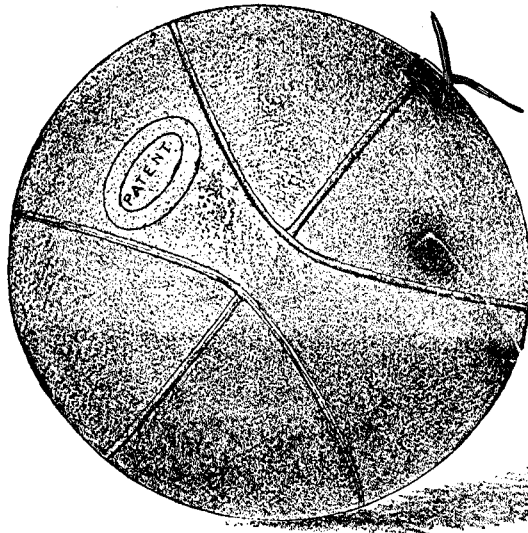

SCOPE OF BOOK.—This book is intended chiefly for pupils preparing for the Primary Examination, but teachers will find that it covers all the ground required for Junior Leaving and Pass Matriculation students.

CONTENTS.—There are three parts: I. Lessons for beginners, introductory to the reading of Caesar. II. A course in Latin Prose Composition, based upon Caesar's idioms and vocabulary. III. A digest of Latin Grammar, as required in ordinary High Schools. In addition to a chapter on the metre of Virgil there are also Vocabularies and an Index.

JOINT AUTHORSHIP.—The authors' names are themselves a guarantee of accurate scholarship and practical methods. The collaboration, and the revision and criticism of each other's work, have produced of the utmost value in securing accuracy and due proportion.

The book is intended for use, not to display knowledge; it is for High School work, as it is or should be, not a book of reference for advanced students; it is progressive, but not radical; it will help the teacher to teach and to train, instead of to cram; it will develop a reading power early, instead of being that to be acquired late, if at all; it is a book of reference and a book for practice, combined, and not confused; it is the only book of similar scope in which references are made in an annotated edition of Caesar.

The type is new and clear, the paper of good quality, and the binding neat and durable.
