CONNECTION BETWEEN WORD DEAFNESS AND DEAFNESS .--- Word deafness has hitherto been ascribed to cerebral lesion, but Keller and а Freund have recently been impressed with the important connection between it and disturbances of the ears, especially of the labyrinth, which is able alone to cause word deafness. They urge the necessity of investigation of the ears in such cases. Keller asserts that isolated speech deafness with retained ability to comprehend other sounds, often corresponds with bilateral affections of the labyrinths, and is dependent upon tone-gaps in that portion of the tone scale which is physiologically important for the comprehension of speech. It sometimes happens that bilateral ear affections which in themselves are not sufficient to cause word deafness. produce it by a secondary degeneration of the nerve tracts and auditory It requires such supreme centres.
