- Note:* (1) Shipments under this quantitative limit may be increased by an amount not to exceed seven percent of the quantitative limit of nylon fabrics in the same calendar year provided that there is a corresponding square yard shortfall in export of nylon fabrics.
- (2) 900,000 square yards of filament polyester sheet fabric (such as voile, batiste, chiffon) and pongee fabrics may be exported to Canada in addition to this quantitative limit in each calendar year. Within this total, either of the two items shall not exceed the level of 600,000 square yards.
- (3) These quantitative limits, excluding the additional quantities provided in (2) above, may be exceeded within a limit of five percent of a quantitative limit for the same textile in the preceding year, by carryover of portions of the latter quantitative limit which were not used for that textile.
