EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated July ¹⁷, 1962, the text of which reads as follows:

"I have the honour to propose, on instructions from my Government, that an agreement for the exchange of information for defence purposes in fields of defence research be concluded between our two Governments as set forth in the attached Memorandum of Understanding.

If this Memorandum of Understanding is acceptable to your Government, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments, which shall come into force one month after the date of your reply and shall remain in force until six months after a notice of termination has been received by either Government.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration".

I have the honour to confirm that the provisions set out in your letter are acceptable to the Government of Greece and therefore agree that Your Excellency's letter and the present reply shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between our two Governments.
