1. For each year 1960 to 1975, what was the (a) amount of profit or loss for each government elevator located within the Canadian Wheat Board area (b) number of bushels handled by each elevator (c) number of cars loaded with grain cleaned to export standards and their destination?

2. Since the utilization of unit trains, how many have originated from each elevator?

3. Has a cost comparison study been done with respect to producer hauled grain to a government elevator and/or grain carried by rail from a country elevator to a government elevator for cleaning to export standards and shipped by unit train for direct loading on shipboard, as opposed to shipping from a country elevator to export position for cleaning and loading and, if so (a) what were the results (b) were the costs of transporting screenings and other foreign material taken into consideration?
