permission of the absent senator, by inserting the name of such senator on the notice in addition to his own.

Two days' notice of certain motions

44. (1) Two days' notice shall be given of any of the following motions:

- (a) to make a new rule or to repeal or amend an existing rule;
- (b) for an address to His Excellency the Governor General not merely formal in its character;
- (c) for an order of the Senate for any papers or documents not relating to a bill or other matter appearing among the Orders of the Day or on the Order Paper;

(d) for the appointment of a special committee;

- (e) for the adoption of the report of a special committee;
- (f) for the second reading of a bill.

(2) A like notice is required of any inquiry not relating to a bill or other matter appearing among the Orders of the Day or on the Order Paper.

One day's notice of certain motions 45. (1) One day's notice shall be given of any of the following motions:

- (a) to suspend any rule or any part thereof;
- (b) for the third reading of a bill;
- (c) for any substantial amendment to a bill reported by a committee;
- (d) for the appointment of a standing committee;
- (e) for an instruction to a committee;
- (f) for the adoption of a report from any standing committee;
- (g) for an adjournment of the Senate, other than the ordinary daily adjournment under Rule 46(r) or that under Rules 13, 36(1), 46(f), 46(g);
- (h) for the making of a substantive motion;
