Earth, shewing its real and imaginary lines and divisions. The word is derived from the Greek Gr. the earth, and GRAPHO, to describe.

2. The elementary part of Geography is so blended with Astronomy, that a proficiency cannot be acquired in the one, without a competent knowledge of the other. 3. Astronomy is that science which exhibits the magnitudes, order, motions, and distances of the Heavenly Bodies; and teaches how to discover the time and quantity of eclipses, and all other celestial phenomena. The term is derived from the Greek words, ASTRON, a star, and NOMOS, a law or rule; and consequently had not originally that extensive meaning, which latter times have annexed to it.
