

form his duties, another member shall be chosen for the balance of his term.

ARTICLE IV.

Sec. 1. Any motion, resolution, complaint, etc. which any member intends to put forward at a General Meeting, must be handed to the Secretary in writing, at least twenty-four hours before the meeting.

Sec. 2. For meetings of the Executive Committee the Secretary shall notify each member.

Sec. 3. For meetings of the Sub-Committees, the Chairman of each Committee shall be responsible for notifying his own Committee of its meetings.

Sec. 4. At any meeting of the Executive Committee, five members shall form a quorum.

Sec. 5. At any meetings of the Sub-Committees three members shall form a quorum.

ARTICLE V.

Sec. 1. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Association, preserve order, enforce the Constitution, and vigilantly watch over the interests of the Association; when the members are equally divided he shall have the deciding vote on all questions. He shall sign all orders drawn on the Treasurer as shall be ordered to be paid by the Finance Committee in compliance with a vote of the majority of all the members present at any stated meeting. He shall have the power to call a meeting whenever he deems it necessary, or when required by ten or more members, and perform
