the Seventh Form, or the french emperorship: because, if the yet future Eighth were any other One out of the preceding Seven, the Seventh Form or the french emperorship plainly could not be healed by its Rise.

"Hence the grand Conclusion from the whole is immediately brought out:

"THE PREDICTED YET FUTURE EIGHTH FORM OF ROMAN GOVERNMENT WILL BE THE REVIVED FRENCH EMPERORSHIP."
