

of Order may be suspended for any session, by a two-thirds vote at that session.

SECTION IV

Order of Proceedings of Convention.

1. At the hour of meeting the chair shall be taken, and the meeting called to order by the presiding officer.
2. The proceedings of each day shall be opened with prayer.
3. The minutes of the preceding session shall be read, and the minutes of such meetings of Executive Committee as have been held since the last Convention, submitted, with Programme of Proceedings for the session as prepared by the Executive Committee.
4. Regular business as arranged by the Executive Committee.
5. New business.
6. Adjournment.
7. Fifteen members shall constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Association, and five at those of its committees.
8. A place shall be provided on the programme for the introduction of motions not arising out of the ordinary business.
