LESSENERED RECEIPTS SEND CORN HIGHER

Fresh Concern Over President Wilson's Health Causes Some Reaction.

Chicago, Oct. 17.—Expected curtailment of receipts did a good deal today to put new strength into the corn market. Prices at the grain, article un-

hed, were 1c to 1 1/2c net higher, December \$1.24; to \$1.24 1/2, and May \$1.27 1/2 to \$1.28. Oats closed unchanged to 1/2c up, and provisions varied from 12c decline to 7c advance.

Traders in corn seemed much impressed by an official announcement that railroads would classify wheat as a preferential freight. This was taken to indicate that the movement of corn to primary markets would be necessarily restricted and that many short sellers of corn might experience difficulty in fulfilling contracts. Bulls asserted also that farmers were systematically holding back shipments, and that with option near the highest price ever known and with other commodities toward the top no important decline was to be expected in grain. During the last part of the day, however, some reaction took

place owing to the fresh concern over President Wilson's health, especially the chance that surgical treatment for him might be required.

Firmness of oats came chiefly from continued export bidding. Profit-taking sales, the increased on the bulge. Provisions were strengthened by upturns in the value of hogs and corn. Besides, packers bought lard rather freely.
