

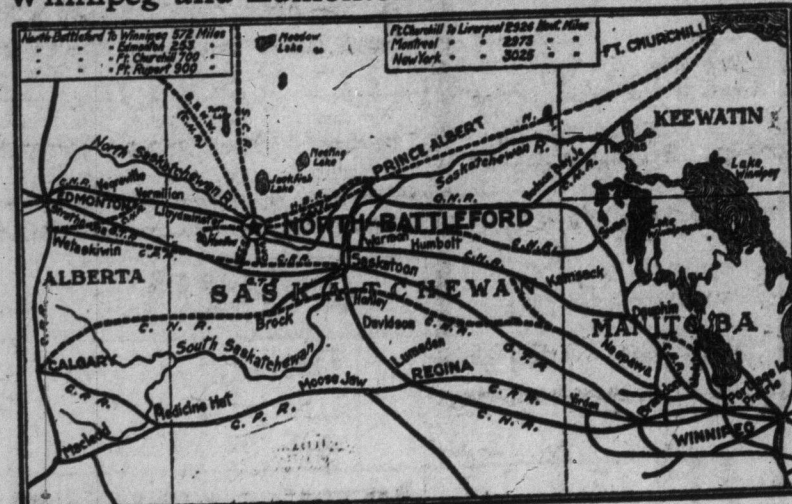

COMPANY TO COMPLETE ERINDALE POWER DAM

Will Deliver 1000 Horse Power to Toronto Within Six Months

The Erindale Power Company, which recently acquired from the Liquidators of the Southern Light and Power Company the power station on Credit River and land holdings at Port Credit harbor, are now arranging to proceed with the construction of the dam and the erection of buildings for the housing of machinery at the station, with a view to delivering 1000 horse-power to the distributors, the Stark Telephone, Light and Power Company, in Toronto, within six months.

About \$200,000 was expended on the plant by the York County Loan Company, and at least \$100,000 more will be expended by the new owners, so a member of the firm said yesterday, to get the plant in proper working condition. A minimum production of 1000 horse-power will be provided, and the capacity will be increased as the demand warrants.

English capitalists, for whom Chas. Holt of London is agent, are behind the Erindale power scheme.

It is understood that subsidiary companies are to take over the Oshawa and Bowmanville holdings of the Stark T. L. and P. Company next week from the liquidator. These undertakings are being financed locally.

New Industry For Parry Sound.

PARRY SOUND, July 8.—The Algoma Lumber Co., which has been in the Jupp in the directorate, have presented plans to the town council for the erection of a wood alcohol and charcoal plant here. It would be at a cost of at least \$75,000, and the terms asked are a loan of \$50,000, to be repaid in 30 years, secured by first mortgage, and a fixed assessment of \$10,000, and the town to supply 20 to 40 horse-power of electric power at \$12.50 per horse-power per annum, electric light at current rates. No money is asked of the town until the plant is in operation.

A bylaw embodying this agreement is to be prepared for submission to the ratepayers at the next meeting of council.

Hudson Bay Company Wins.

LONDON, July 8.—In the court of appeals to-day, in the case of Stevens v. Hudson Bay Co., the court allowed the company's appeal from the decision of Mr. Justice Channel. The case raised the question of the liability of the company to bring into account for purposes of assessment for income tax the sum of \$17,567 realized on the sale of land during the last of the three years of the profits to be assessed. Their lordships hold that the sum in question is not to be regarded as profits or gains derived by the company, and further, that Judge Channel was wrong in holding that the company carried on the business of dealing in and selling land.

CUTHBERT PARTY EN ROUTE

C. P. R. Special With 156 Passengers Start on 8000 Mile Tour.

At 8 o'clock last night C. P. R. special with Engineer J. Uquhart at the throttle and Conductor George Woods in charge, pulled out of the Union Station with 156 people on board, composing Mrs. E. W. Cuthbert's annual tour to the Pacific coast. The train was a magnificent specimen of Canadian standard railway equipment, and consisted of C. P. R. compound express locomotive 779, baggage car, first-class passenger coach, one diner, one compartment car and three tourist sleepers.

The party will travel via C. P. R. to Detroit, Wabash to Chicago, Santa Fe and Southern Pacific to San Francisco, Northern Pacific to Seattle, and return via the Canadian Rockies over the C. P. R.

While en route stop-overs will be made at Chicago, St. Louis, Kansas City, Denver, Grand Canyon, Col., Pasadena, Redondo, Petrified Forest of Arizona, Los Angeles, San Francisco and Seattle, where they will visit the Pacific-Yukon-Alberta Exposition. Re-entering Canada the party will take in Victoria, Vancouver, Banff and other points in the mountain wonderland of British Columbia, and pass over the prairies in time to bring home a bull crop report.

Thirty days will be required for the entire trip and will be accompanied by J. J. Ross, traveling passenger agent of the C. P. R., and J. A. Richardson, district passenger agent of the Wabash.
