OF THE

TORONTO SABBATH SCHOOL UNION.

I.

That this Society shall be designated the "Toronto Sabbath School Union."

II.

The objects of this Society shall be,—1st. To encourage and promote the efficiency of all engaged in Sabbath Schools. 2ndly. To disseminate Bible instruction. 3rdly. To organize Schools in destitute places, and aid others when necessary. 4thly, To adopt means to bring all children, as far as practicable, under Sabbath School instruction; and 5thly. To enlist the prayers and efforts of churches generally in behalf of the rising generation.

III.

This Society shall be composed of Sabbath School Superintendents, Officers and Teachers, who assent to the terms of this Constitution, and are engaged in schools recognized by any evangelical denomination.

IV.

The Officers of this Union shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, with an Executive Committee of five, elected by the Union at their Annual Meeting. Superintendents, and one delegate from each School in connection with the Society, shall be *ex-officio* members of the Committee.

V.

The Annual Meeting of the Society shall be held on the third Monday in January, at which time the Office-bearers and Committee shall be elected for the ensuing year.

VI.

There shall be a general quarterly meeting of the Society, on the third Monday evening in January, April, July, and October, for
