Canadian vital statistics. The publications of the Census Department continue the good work of telling Canada about herself, and among the most interesting figures published are those connected with the vital statistics of the country.

The Registrar General, Mr. J. H. G. Macdonald, has issued his annual report on the vital statistics of the Dominion for the year 1911. The report shows that the birth rate in 1911 was 23.2 per 1,000, as compared with 22.8 in 1910. The death rate was 10.7 per 1,000, as compared with 10.5 in 1910. The natural increase was 12.5 per 1,000, as compared with 12.3 in 1910.
