Early in the day, records began to go starting with a fine performance by A. R. Taplay, a Finn, in the discus throwing, best hand, final, 200 meters, (148 feet 1 1/2 inches) he beat not only the olympic record of 136 feet, 13 inches made by Sheridan in Athens in 1906, but also the world's record of 145 feet 3/4 inches established by Jas. H. Duncan at Celtic Park, New York, on June 2, this year.
