THIS book treats of that obscure but crucial period in Christian history, between the death of Jesus and the earliest letters of Paul. The author endeavors to answer such questions as these: With what aims and hopes did the earliest disciples organize themselves into a church? What was their attitude toward Jesus? What social ideals prompted their communistic mode of living as described by Luke? Why did they establish the rite of baptism, which apparently was not thought of by Jesus himself? What was the original meaning of the Lord's Supper? How much of Paul's rich gospel was derived from those who were disciples before him? The book is scientific in method, untechnical in presentation and reverent in spirit. It is just the book for the scholar or layman who seriously wishes to understand the original meaning of Christianity.
