

ment of the said Province;” and by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this Act, so much of the second clause of an Act passed in the thirty-third year of His late Majesty’s Reign, entitled, “An Act to provide for the Nomination and Appointment of Parish and Town Officers within this Province,” as relates to the taking a true and complete list of every male and female inhabitant, by the Town Clerk, within the limits of his parish, town or township, and returning the same to the Justices in General Quarter Sessions assembled, in the month of April, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

II. *And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the passing of this Act, it shall be the duty of the Assessors chosen or appointed for any parish, township, reputed township, place or places, in this Province, to take a true and correct List of all the inhabitants of the parish, township, place or places for which they may be chosen or appointed, which List shall be in the following form:—

And it shall and may be lawful for the Assessors, or one of them, and they are hereby required to demand from every inhabitant, householder, or head of a family, at the usual place of residence of such householder, or head of a family, a true and correct List of the number of persons composing such family, male and female, and their respective ages, including therein, all persons employed by, or resident with, such householder; and if such inhabitant, householder, or head of a family, shall refuse
