WHEREAS, for the encouragement of Education, it is expedient that several sums of Moncy should be granted for the establishment and support of Elenienary Scliools throughout this Island, and that Regulations should be made for the proper expenditure of such Monies, and the managenent of tho said Sclools.
I.- Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor and Assembly, in General Aseembly convened, that from and out of such Monies as shall from time to time remain in the hands of the Colonial Treasurer, unappropriated, there be granted to Her Majesty, her heirs and succes- tio sors, anumally, for the period of Years, from and after the..passing of this Act, the sum of $£ 4985$; which said sum of money shall be annually distributed, one part in the support of Schools appropriated to the instruction of the children of Members of the seyeral Reformed Cburches; and the remaining port in the support of Schools appropriated to the instruction of the children of Members of the Roman Cathlic Church.
