NEWFOUNDLAND.

A BILL for the encouragement of Education in this Colony.

[Words in Italics, and Sums in Figures, to be filled up in Committee.]

WHEREAS, for the encouragement of Education, it is expedient that several sums of Money should be granted for the establishment and support of Elementary Schools throughout this Island, and that Regulations should be made for the proper expenditure of such Monies, and the management of the said Schools.

I.—Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor and Assembly, in General Assembly convened, that from and out of such Monies as shall from time to time remain in the hands of the Colonial Treasurer, unappropriated, there be granted to Her Majesty, her heirs and successors, annually, for the period of *Years*, from and after the passing of this Act, the sum of £4985; which said sum of money shall be annually distributed, one part in the support of Schools appropriated to the instruction of the children of Members of the *several* Reformed Churches, and the remaining part in the support of Schools appropriated to the instruction of the children of Members of the Roman Catholic Church.

£4985 annually granted for purposes of education.

To be divided between Protestants and Catholics.

II.—And be it further enacted, that the said sum of £4985 shall be applied and expended under the superintendence of Boards of Education, to be appointed as hereinafter prescribed, in the several Educational Districts hereinafter named, in the proportions following; that is to say:—In the District of St. John's, £1250,—of which £320 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £930 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Brigus, the sum of £375,—of which £155 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £220 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Harbor Grace, the sum of £560,—of which £360 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £200 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Carbonear, the sum of £600,—of which £350 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board,—and £250 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Trinity Bay, North, £250,—of which £200 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £50 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board; In the District of Trinity Bay, South, the sum of £210,—of which £185 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £25 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Bonavista Bay, South, £230,—of which £155 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £75 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Bonavista Bay, North, £125,—of which £115 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £10 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Fogo, the sum of £115,—of which £75 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £40 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Twillingate, the sum of £205,—of which £190 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board, and £15 at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board;—In the District of Bay Bulls, the sum of £140, to be at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board,—there being no Protestant Board required in that District;—In the District of Ferryland, the sum of £205,—of which £180 shall be at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board, and £25 at the disposal of the Protestant Board;—In the district of St. Mary's £75, to be at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board,—there being no Protestant Board required in that District;—In the District of Placentia, £230,—of which £185 shall be at the disposal of the Roman Catholic Board, and £45 at the disposal of the Protestant Board;—In the District of Burin, £205,—of which £115 shall be at the disposal of the Protestant Board.
