formed by the intersection of a line commencing on the north side of the River Waganson, (a branch of the said River Ristigouche,) opposite to the cross on the north side of the said River Waganses, at the extremity of the Ristigouche Portage, running from thence on a due north course about forty-five miles, or until intersected by the above-mentioned line of the said District, which constitutes a part of its northelly bounds; and the two other abovementioned lines its western bounds; thence from Cape Chat, eastward, along the borders of the River and Gulf St. Lawrence, and thence up Chalcurs Bay and the River Ristigouche, to the cross aforesaid; including in the said District all the Islands in the River and Gulf of St. Lawrence, the Bay of Chaleurs and tha River Ristigouche, in front thereof, in whole or in part nearest to the said District: The County of Cornwallis shall be bounded on the east and north-east by the west and north-west. boundary lines of the County and Inferior District of Gaspe, as above described; on the south-east by the north-east boundary line. of the County of Devon, as the same hath heretofore been, running from the Saint Laws rence, south-easterly, along the north-east; boundary line of the Seigniory of St. Rock der Aunais, to its depth, and continuing the same. course along the north-east boundary line of the Township of Ashford, to the depth thereof; thence by the prolongation of the said boundary, line to the southern boundary of the Province; and shall comprehend; the Islands of St. Barnaby and Bic, and all other Islands in the said River St. Lawrence, nearest to the said, County, and in the whole or in part frontingthe same. The County of Devon shall be bounded on the north-east by the south-west. boundary line of the County of Cornwallis; on, the south-west by the north-east boundary line, of the Seigniory of Berthier, running from the St. Lawrence southerly along the said boundary. line till intersected by the Riviere du suds thence along the south west boundary bing of the Seigniory of Lepinaye, on a south east. course, to the depth thereof, and thence on tho. same course continued to the southern boundary of the Province; and shall comprehend alli the Islands in the River St. Lawrence nearestr to the said County, and in the whole or in part, fronting the same. The County of Hertford. shall be bounded on the north-east by the south-west boundary line of the County of Dear von; on the south-west by the north-east boundary line of the Seigniories of Lauzon and Jolliet, running from the St. Lawrence souther east along Lauzon, to its depth, thence same course along the Seigniory of Jolliet to the north west boundary line of the Township of Frampton, then north-easterly along the said
