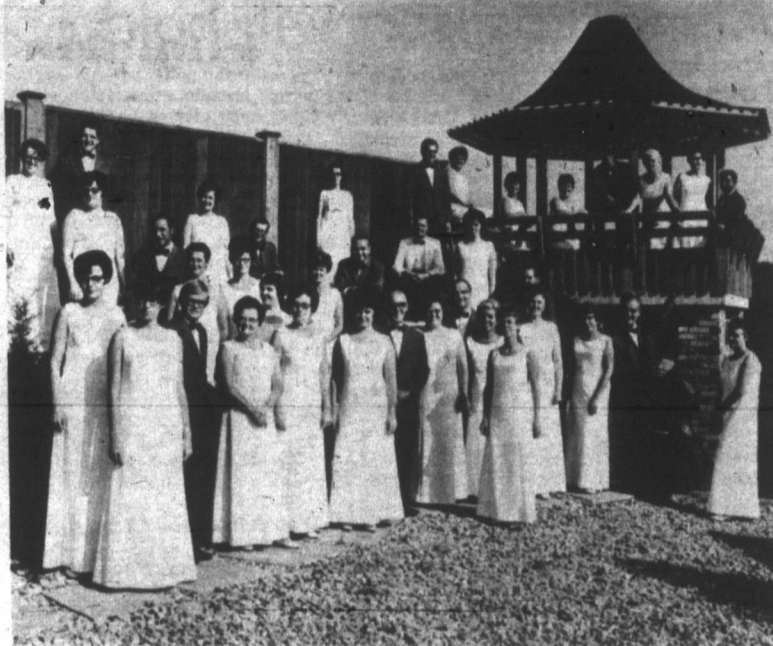
So I take heart. And gather up my spirit. Maybe the best is yet to come!

## Woodstock Choraliers will appear at Erindale United

The 11 a.m. service at Erindale United Church Oct. 17, will be devoted entirely to a special musical presentation by the celebrated Woodstock Choraliers under the direction of Dr. Norman Burt-Gerrans.

The presentation will be a 45-minute compilation of music forming a musical version of the Life of Christ. The same performance was given in February of 1970 at St. David's United Church in Woodstock. Included in the program will be the inspiring

Russian Orthodox hymn, Hosposdi Pomilui, which will be sung in the narthex after the recessional postlude.

The men of the group will be dressed in their traditional red jackets and black pants forming a colourful background for the ladies who will be wearing long white evening gowns.

After the church service the Choraliers will be luncheon guests of Erindale United Church's senior choir before leaving for a second engagement for the Bramalea Baptist Church in

the auditorium of Bramalea Secondary School.

The group consists of some 55 experienced singers representing all the voice ranges of the musical scale. The members represent all major Christian denominations, many vocations and nationalities, and a wide age spread from late "teens" to early "seventies." Some family units are included in the membership. At present there are waiting lists for auditions for all voice ranges within the group.

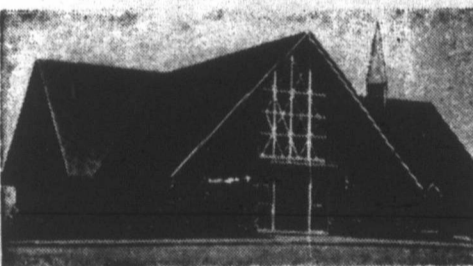
