CONCLUSION OF EVIDENCE.

1 Q You own the two places, 83 Dupont and 79?

A. Yes, two numbers.

2 Q The Kong Lung Hing Company? A. My tenants.

3 Q Both buildings? A. Yes

4 Q Did they pay you for the damage done to both places?

A. I leave everything to him. I paid that \$14.75 and \$34., paid them this morning.

5 Q Why did you pay them this morning? A. My friend told me to pay and show you the bill.

6 Q Did you have the window lettered the same as before?

Did you have a much finer sign than before? A. Sign all the same as before.

7 Q Didn't you make it more elaborate? A. Do nothing like that.

8 Q In which house was this you fixed the glass, both?

A. Both together.

9 Q The total amount you paid is \$34. and \$14.75? A. Yes
