Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 7th instant, with which you submitted an application from Wm. Mahmabin for a loan of \$350.00, wherewith to purchase a farm team, I beg to say that the Department approves of the loan in question being made upon the conditions which obtain with respect to previous loans granted. It will be necessary for the animals to be examined by a veterinary surgeon before purchase, and his certificate as their soundness will have to be furnished. The certificate should accompany the voucher when submitted for payment.

In future when submitting applications such as the above you should give the number of persons in the applicant's family in order that it may be known what number of shares of interest money will be retained towards re-payment of the loan.
