Sir: -

In reply to your letter of the 1st.inst.

submitting an application on behalf of Frank
Lockwood of the Tobique band for permission to
cut 400 logs from the Reserve for the purpose
of improving his nouse. I have to state that
a permit for this quantity may be given him,
subject to the payment of dues in the event of
the timber being sold.

If the transaction goes through your
hards and the entire proceeds from the sale of

hands and the entire proceeds from the sale of the logs are used for the purchase of lumber and material for his house, the collection of dues may be waived.

The Department cannot consider the question of a losn of \$50 to enable him to haul his logs.

Doubtless the purchaser of the logs will accomodate Lockwood to this extent.
