- (b) in conjunction with the Department of Labour, to study and report upon the available supplies of labour in Canada,
- (c) to study and report upon the demands and needs of industry for labour,
- (d) "to aid in a systematic way in directing those seeking employment to employment by employers and toward training facilities which may be available".
- (e) The further duty of this Division will be to direct the carrying out of The National War Services Regulations, 1940, (Recruits). See Expense note mobilization

## Duties of Division of Material Resources

The Division of Material Resources will:

- (a) Conduct such surveys as are necessary to the mobilization of the material resources of the nation,
- (b) aid and direct the development of the nation's material resources,
- (c) aid in the co-ordination of the productive efforts of the industries of the nation,
  - (d) aid in the production, maintenance and distribution of the food supplies necessary to the successful prosecution of the war,
  - (e) study the future industrial developments of the
