(I) COS 59. From General Stuart to Colonel Halston. April 25th, 1944.

(1) General Eisenhower and General Beedel Smith will see General Stuart at any time in order to discuss operations or operational planning not only for operations in which Canadian troops might be involved but concerning operations in general.

(2) General Smith would welcome a Canadian officer, on Brigadier level, in the operational and planning side of his staff, such officer to be a member of SHAEP and responsible only to himself and General Eisenhower and to bring to the attention of General Smith any point or points in which Canadian interests might be involved.
