

THIS INDENTURE, made this *Eleventh* - day of November in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight BETWEEN THE ORDER OF THE OBLATES OF MARY IMMACULATE, in the Province of British Columbia, hereinafter called The Corporation of the one part, and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, represented by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs for the time being of the Dominion of Canada, of the other part WHEREAS— The Corporation is seised of or otherwise entitled to the inheritance in fee simple of and in the lands hereditaments and premises hereby granted free from incumbrances:— AND WHEREAS the said lands hereditaments and premises have been selected by Her Majesty represented as aforesaid as a suitable site for the establishment of an Industrial School for Indians and The Corporation have agreed to grant and convey the said lands, hereditaments and premises unto Her Majesty Her heirs and successors represented as aforesaid free from incumbrances NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the premises and the sum of \$1.00 (one dollar) of money lawful and current in British Columbia by Her Majesty in hand paid to The Corporation— at or before the execution of these presents, the receipt and payment of which said sum the Corporation doth hereby acknowledge— and of and from the same and every part thereof doth hereby acquit, release and forever discharge Her Majesty, her heirs and successors represented as aforesaid and her and their lands, goods and chattel the said Corporation doth hereby grant and convey unto Her Majesty Her heirs and successors represented as aforesaid All that piece or parcel of land containing 33, 1/3 acres, more or less, situated on the right bank of the St. Mary's
