EXPLANATION

No records of meetings of Session can be found before the year 1884.

The Managers' book for the years 1886-1898 cannot be found. Hence list of Managers is incomplete, as far as this period is concerned.

NOTES

At the annual meeting of the congregation on January 18th, 1870, the revenue of the congregation for the support of ordinances was reported to be \$378.26. This amount included \$115.50, the proceeds of two soirees.

As illustrating the changed methods of church work, the following item, taken from the report of a meeting of the Board of Management held in 1870, is interesting :

"Moved and seconded,—That those of the church who live in
"the country each contribute a cord of wood for the use of the
"minister, and those who live in the village cut it.—Carried."
