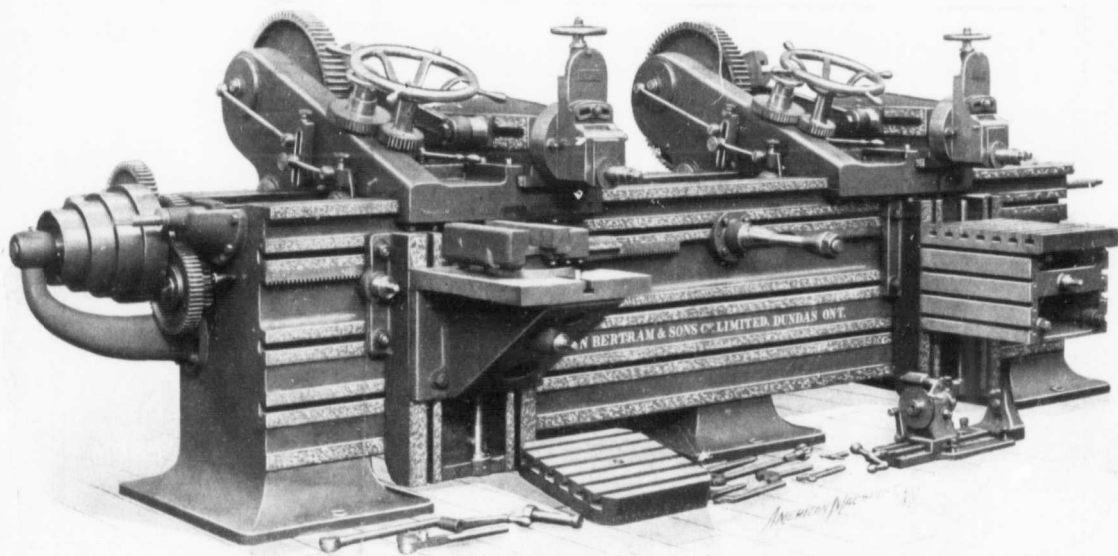

TRAVELLING HEAD SHAPERS SINGLE and DOUBLE HEAD 12 to 26 Inch STROKE



To take heavy cuts at extreme end of stroke



26-Inch Bertram Double Head Shaping Machine

Built with belt or motor drive. Motors have speed change of 2 to 1, and with speed changes by gearing machine will give from 4 to 40 strokes per minute. Maximum stroke 26 inches. Vertical travel of tool-slide, 8 inches. Machine may be provided with various attachments, including index centers, vise and cone arbor.
