The Peterboro Cement Roofing Company, Limited, have been registered by the Saskatchewan Government.

The St. Lawrence Presed Brick & Terra Cotta Company, Limited, of Montreal, and Lortie & Peachy, painters and carpenters, of St. Raymond, Que., have registered.

The high-pressure water system for the fire protection of Winnipeg, Canada, is equipped with four sets of double-acting three-throw pumps, each having a capacity of 1,800 imp. gal. per minute against a pressure of 300 lb. per square inch. and with two sets each able to deliver 900 gal. per minute. These pumps are operated with three gas engines, one of 540 h.p. and two of 270 h.p. each, all using producer gas. The air-compressing plant and storage tanks are in duplicate, and are so arranged that the whole plant can be started within one minute after an alarm has been received. The heavy cast iron mains, 20 in. in diameter, have been laid in the principle business districts and are constantly kept charged with water. The pumps were made and erected by Messrs. Glenfield & Kennedy, Ltd., and the engines and producer plant by Messrs. Crossley Brothers, of Manchester, Eng.
