Holland Is Planning To Drain Zuider Zee Thus Making New State

The plans of the Government of Holland do not mis-carry, Queen Wilhelmina will have another State added to her little Kingdom.

The Dutch intend to reclaim the whole of the Zuider Zee from the grasp of the ocean. The idea is now being considered by the Second Chamber of the Netherlands Parliament, and the engineers propose to dam the body of troublesome water, thus creating a hinterland at home

instead of looking for colonial expansion. It will suggest to outsiders that the Dutch feel that the danger of German aggression has now been thoroughly mastered by the Allies, so that Queen Wilhelmina and her people need no longer have fears for the integrity of their country.

The plan under consideration provides for a dam across the upper part of the Zuider Zee, extending from the province of North Holland, over the Amsteldiep (a narrow
