Early Banking Operations

NOT PROFITABLE.

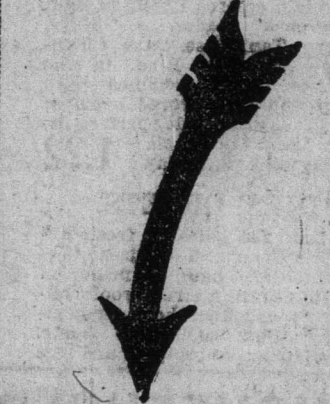
