A meeting of the ministers and laymen of the Wesleyan Methodist Church in the Guelph District was held in the Wesleyan Methodist Church of this town Thursday afternoon.

THE REV. RICHARD JONES NEXT CAME FORWARD AND GAVE A GENERAL STATEMENT OF THE HISTORY OF VICTORIA COLLEGE.

Mr. Panshan then read the amounts contributed in aid of the Endowment Fund, the total of which was some \$37,000.

THE SECRETARY THEN READ THE AMOUNTS CONTRIBUTED IN AID OF THE ENDOWMENT FUND.

Mr. Panshan stated that every fraction of a penny contributed would be sacredly kept for the Endowment Fund of Victoria University.

The Rev. Mr. Lavelle occupied the chair, and addresses were delivered by the Rev. Messrs. Jones and Panshan which embraced the ground occupied by them in their speeches in the afternoon.

A BILL HAS BEEN INTRODUCED INTO THE AMERICAN CONGRESS TO CHANGE AND AMEND THE NATURALIZATION LAWS.

The principal change is, that the power to naturalize foreigners is to be confined to the Federal Courts. Hitherto the state Courts have issued the naturalization papers, and conferred the rights of citizenship on foreigners.
