

ALMA COLLEGE BACKS UNIVERSITY AFFILIATION

100 Students Added to University Roster by St. Thomas Move.

REMAIN IN RESIDENCE

Girl Students Will Get Two Years' Arts Studies at St. Thomas.

St. Thomas, May 15.—The Alma college board, in a formal resolution, have approved of the affiliation of the ladies' college and Western University. This step will enable Alma students to take the first two years of university work in this city as well as develop themselves in the crafts and music, for which the college is noted.

Study at St. Thomas.

Students of Alma will continue to take commerce, music and a broad art course, and the affiliation will be on the basis of a junior school. The first two years of the arts course will be taught here, and the third year philosophy.

A student at Alma seeking a bachelor's degree will take two years here and three at Western. For an honor course three years will be required at each. No science will be taught at Alma.

Principal Dobson will become a faculty and senate member of the university.

This is the second affiliation in seven weeks. Waterloo college, a Lutheran institution, having affiliated and will start 30 students towards their university degrees this fall.

There are 300 students enrolled at Alma college. Of these 80 are now in residence there.

WEST MIDDLESEX TORIERS RE-NAMED

Mount Brydges, May 15.—Despite the fact that Frank White, M. P. for London, and George Elliott, M.L.A. for North Middlesex, did their best to stir up a little enthusiasm at the annual meeting of the West Middlesex Conservatives here yesterday, no mention was made during the entire session as to the calling of a convention to nominate a candidate for the federal house.

The prevailing opinion in this district for some time has been that the Conservatives have no chance of winning West Middlesex, some of the strongest members of the party stating emphatically that the Liberal candidate in this riding they will most certainly vote for him.

Candidate Doubtful.

It is very doubtful in view of the fact that a convention was not even considered, if the Conservatives will nominate a candidate at all. Frank White, devoting most of his time to a history of the Progressives in the dominion government.

The usual resolutions upholding the leadership of Hon. Arthur Meighan and Premier Ferguson were passed amid "enthusiasm." George Elliott declaring that the Ferguson government was the best that Ontario had ever known. He declared emphatically that the Conservatives had not broken faith with the temperance people by introducing the bill. He felt that the government was making temperance legislation more stringent, and devoted much time to telling the audience of the noxious liquor being sold by bootleggers.
