

Prices of Building Materials.

CONDITION OF THE MARKET.

TORONTO: Trade remains much the same as last week, the only advance in price being for pig iron, which has advanced from 50 cents to \$1 a ton. Iron pipe is still scarce, and prices are in a more settled condition. The demand for plumber's supplies and galvanized iron is brisk, while iron pipe and soil pipe are quiet. The glass market shows a slight improvement.

MONTREAL. Building operations have not improved as much as was anticipated, and the market is without much activity. A fair business is reported in general hardware and paints and oils. The receipts of cement last week were 500 English and Belgian nil, against 4,875 English and 4,577 Belgian the previous week.
