EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to discussions which have taken place between representatives of our two Governments concerning the establishment of an air training programme between Canada and Denmark and to propose that the arrangements set out in the Schedule annexed to this Note should regulate the programme.

I have the honour to propose that, if the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of Denmark, this Note together with its annex, both of which are authentic in English and French, and your reply to that effect shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply and which may be terminated by either party upon six months' notice in writing to the other, or by either party without previous notification where the party terminating the agreement determines that such termination is in the national interest.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
