PRAYERS.

By unanimous consent, it was ordered,—That the Orders for second reading of Bills C-14, C-72, C-78, C-87, C-97, C-101 and C-120 be discharged and the subject-matters thereof be referred to the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections.

Mr. Prud'homme, seconded by Mr. Guilbault, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-173, An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Attempted suicide), which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.
