Sir William Van Horne's Farm is situated in this municipality. The yield of wheat off this farm last year was thirty-five bushels to the acre, and weighed sixty-two pounds to the bushel, and which was generally indicative of the crop results of the surrounding farmers.

The northern portion of this municipality, particularly towards Winnipeg, is exceptionally adapted to stock raising; natural grasses for hay and grazing grow in profusion. The country is well watered by the tributaries of the creeks. The Winnipeg River, already referred to, and now becoming so famous for its magnificent water-falls in connection with which Eastern Capitalists are developing some of the best water plants on the continent, has become a centre of interest to the people of Winnipeg, Selkirk and other industrial centres. Along the banks of this river a settlement is rapidly developing of industrious and enterprising farmers.
