

**POSTSCRIPT.**

AT the moment when this work is ready to issue from the press, fresh accounts from St. Domingo officially published in France, are laid before the English Public; and if the information contained in the Advertisement prefixed to these Letters, was not unnecessary to guard the writer from being suspected of disingenuousness, it seems still more requisite now to strengthen that precaution, by requesting the Reader's attention to the date of the present publication; for so fully are some of the most important of his conjectures confirmed by these official papers, that he might otherwise very probably be suspected of having wished to give to speculations founded on known events, a false air of political foresight. Let it therefore be observed that this work is delivered to the Public on the morning after the publication of General Leclerc's and Admiral Villaret's dispatches of February 16, in the London newspapers.
