THE MOST RECENT UNION.—A notable event in the ecclesiastical annals of the nineteenth century was that of the Free Church of Scotland with the United Presbyterian Church of Scotland, consummated at Edinburgh on the 31st day of October, 1900. The name of the new organization is THE UNITED FREE CHURCH OF SCOTLAND.
