¶ Instead of the Venite, the following Hymn shall be used.

Sing unto the Lord * new Song : sing unto the Lord, all the whole earth.

Sing unto the Lord, and praise His name: be telling of His

salvation from day to day.

Ascribe unto the Lord, O ye kindreds of the people:

ascribe unto the Lord worship and power.

For Thou, Lord, hast made us glad through Thy works : we will rejoice in giving praise for the operations of Thy hands,

Who can express the noble acts of the Lord; or shew forth all His praise.

He hath given us our heart's desire: and hath not denied

the request of our lips.

O that men would therefore praise the Lord for His goodness: and declare the wonders that He doeth for the children of men. who were the control of the contro

That they would offer unto Him the sacrifice of thanksgiv-

ing: and tell out His works with gladness. That they would exalt him also in the congregation of the

people: and praise Him in the seat of the elders.

For His merciful kindness is ever more and more towards us: and the truth of the Lord and ureth for ever and ever. Praise the Lord.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son : and to the Holy Ghost:

As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be: World without end. Amen.
