EQUALIZED TELEGRAPH RATES.

The Winnipeg Free Press points out
that the west is being discriminated
against in the matter of telegraph
rates as well as in the matter of
railway freight and express rates.
Telegraph tolls in Western Canada are
said to be from 50 to 200 per cent.
higher than in Eastern Canada, al-
though it costs no more to construct and
operate telegraph lines in the west than it
does in the east and the density of
business per mile is greater in the
west. The case made out against
discriminatory telegraph rates in the
west is much the same as that made
out before the Dominion Railway Com-
mission by M. K. Cowan, K.C., against
discriminatory freight rates in the
west.

The Canadian Pacific established its
present telegraph rates in the west
when it had no competition, but in the
east it was compelled to charge on the
more reasonable scale which it
found already established by the Great
Northwestern Company. The latter
had agreed to a 10-words-for-a-quarter-
rate over a fairly wide area; when it
obtained authority from parliament to
take over its constituent companies,
and its rates generally were and are
quite moderate in comparison with
those charged at present by the Cana-
dian Pacific Company and all other
companies in Western Canada.

The Free Press hopes for relief in
this and in kindred matters from the
railway commission, and The World
sincerely hopes that the commission
has jurisdiction over express rates and
telegraph rates is due, we submit, in
no small measure to this paper, and
to the persistent activity of W. F.
Maclean in parliament. Its jurisdic-
tion should be, and we believe will be,
exercised to prevent discrimination be-
tween localities where conditions are
substantially similar, but the only ab-
solute cure for the present situation
is equalization of passenger, freight,
express and telegraph rates in all
parts of the Dominion and from sea
to sea. This will require parliamentary
action and newspapers like The Free
Press, which has done good service
for the people in battling against rail-
way extortion, should call upon par-
liament to act, when and as soon as it
is summoned to Ottawa by the govern-
ment.

PUBLIC OWNERSHIP IN PRETORIA.

Ten years have passed since the
signing of the peace treaty of Vereen-
gen, which brought the Boer war to a
close. Four years and a half later the
Liberal government of Sir Henry Camp-
bell-Bannerman surprised the world
with the conference of full self-govern-
ment on the Transvaal and the Orange
River State, which led directly to
the formation of the Union of South
Africa. Pretoria, the capital of the
Transvaal, became the administrative
capital of the Union, and its growth
for the ten years from May 31, 1902, to
May 31, 1912, forms the subject of a
special article that appeared recently
in The Transvaal Leader. In all de-
partments of the city administration
there has been remarkable progress,
and it is interesting to observe that
the municipalization of Pretoria's public
services, which occurred at various
dates within that period, has in all cases
been followed by marked benefit. As
regards health protection the improve-
ment is equally apparent, the death
rate for Europeans for the three years
ending June, 1908, being 10.2 per thou-
sand, whilst for the three following
years it fell to only 8.8 per thousand.

In 1902 the city acquired the assets
of the Pretoria Water Leading Com-
pany, to whom the concession had been
granted. The company's charges were
high, arbitrary and variable, and under
municipal management are now ap-
proximately fifty per cent. lower, while
the number of consumers has nearly
doubled. In 1904 the city purchased
back the electric supply service held
by the Pretoria Lighting Company, which,
in 1902, supplied 650 consumers with
600,000 units at 26 cents a unit. For
the present year the consuming
number 3367, the output is 2,000,000,
and the charges are 12 cents per unit
for lighting, 4 cents for cooking and other
domestic purposes, and for power and
day load, a sliding scale from 6 cents to
1.12 cents. Miles of street lighting
have been added, not only within the
limits of Pretoria proper, but in every
direction throughout the suburbs. There
are significant figures exemplifying
the almost invariably the case, the su-
preme advantages of municipally oper-

ated services when conducted on busi-
ness lines.

Just the same benefits attended the
purchase of the street railway com-
pany's assets and concession in 1903,
there being then three and a half miles
of single track and one route only, run
by horse power. There are now many
miles of electric railways, claimed to
be the finest in the world, running from
Church-square in all directions. The
fares per stage are four cents cash and
two and a half cents by coupon, the
latter being obtainable in books of 12
for 20 cents. "Pretoria," says the spe-
cial correspondent of The Leader, "is
indeed supplied with cheap vehicular
locomotion, superior to and more ade-
quate than that of any town of its size
in the world." Thirteen and a half
miles of track have been laid in con-
nection with the electric railways, and
four miles of the Apples River, which
used to run in a zig-zag course thru the
town, have been canalized and now run
in a graceful course, with concrete bot-
tom, sides and ornamental wall. Much
fine architectural work has been done,
and the preliminary outlay on Church-
square will amount to \$180,000. Alto-
gether, Pretoria appears to be a thoroly
up-to-date city, imbued with those pro-
gressive principles that are so indis-
pensable in the public interest.

PARTY SPOILS SYSTEM.

One thing to be taken to heart from
the New York police conspiracy case is
the fact that it is the direct and in-
evitable outcome of the party system in
politics. We have the nucleus of the
spoils system in operation in Toronto,
and its leaders use coercion according
to their ability, and are rewarded with
office and patronage.

In a century from to-day will the
ideals of the practice in Toronto be
better than those of New York if we
preserve and cherish the same system
that has debauched the New York
police force?

WORSE BEFORE, BETTER?

No such scathing indictment has
been brought against the city hall by
anyone as by the city hall itself. One
of the latest things done there was to
change the method of construction of
certain work to be done. The change
is made, we are told, not because the
new way is better or cheaper or more
durable, but because the workmen
could not be trusted to do good work
or the inspectors and engineers to see
good work done under the other
method. In other words, that they
were incompetent and inefficient and
unreliable. And in proof we are told
that the falling in of a concrete cul-
vert is a case in point.

The World believes that the incom-
petence and the inefficiency which
have been so obvious at the city hall
for years; and which have cost the
citizens one or two unnecessary mil-
lions a year, are the result of the sys-
tem. The system largely depends on
ward influence, society or lodge pull,
and political affiliation. So long as
the people are satisfied with a system
which gives these elements free play,
so long the city hall will continue to
furnish incompetent direction and
super-tax-bills.

We have the greatest sympathy
with the effort now being made in the
works department, but we cannot
blind ourselves to the fact that strong
men have been broken on the system
before, or abandoned it in disgust.
And a change that prolongs the life
of the system for another year or two
is not a final remedy.

REVOLUTION IS ON THE WAY.

The situation in New York City is
one of many striking indications that
the system of government we had al-
most said the civilization of the United
States is breaking down. When the
police of a great city shoot down in
the street and kill a witness, to pre-
vent him testifying to their corrupt
alliance with vice, and thru their
agents threaten high officers of the
state with assassination, unless the
murderers go unpunished, a state of
anarchy prevails. Sponser or later some
strong man must restore order.

As to this particular city, it might
be left to work out its own salvation,
were it surrounded and influenced by
orderly and well-governed communi-
ties. We fear, however, that conditions
in New York will be found reproduced,
to a large extent, in nearly all the
cities of the United States, and that
they are governed by a band of politi-
cians who draw their support from
the big corporations and form the un-
der-world of vice and that they pre-
sident avarice, the election machinery
is so manipulated that the large body
of virtuous and well-meaning citizens
are unable to bring about any lasting
change or permanent reform.

The state legislatures are so gener-
ally suspected of venality and inec-
pacity that there is a general demand
that power to elect U. S. senators be
taken away from them and that their
control over the cities be curtailed as
much as possible. As to the courts
and judges, it is not unfair to say
that they are not trusted by the people
to withstand strong political pressure
or the influence of the great corpora-
tions.

Where then shall the people turn
for relief? Congress has only limited
and delegated powers, and its decrees
may be set aside by hundreds of judges,
responsible to no one. The situation,
every day growing more acute, when
they are evidenced by dynamite in Los
Angeles, oppression of the poor in
Lawrence, Mass., anarchy in New York,

Canadian Pacific Preparing
For Another Issue of Stock

Belief Prevails That Authority to Increase Capitalization
Will Be Requested From Parliament Soon.

A member of a New York banking
house with London connections says
the belief is taking hold in Canadian
financial circles that when parliament
meets again in Ottawa, Canadian Pacific
Railway will apply for authority
to increase the amount of its author-
ized common stock capitalization. This
banker has just returned from a trip
thru eastern and middle western Cana-
da. According to him there is much
discussion on every hand as to the
form which the next bonus to Canadian
Pacific stockholders will take.

In some quarters, he says, it is as-
serted that it will take the form of
an increase in the regular dividend
rate to 12 per cent. Another view
of the rapidly expanding earnings
could be easily enough sustained. Others
still seem to hold the belief that a
plan will be formulated whereby the
large extraneous assets of the com-
pany will be segregated from the rail-
road assets and properties, and a new
company created to represent them. But
the majority is anticipating a new issue
of common stock at 150 or 165, with
accompanying valuable "rights" accord-
ing to shareholders.

The circumstances giving rise to
this expectation of new financing, the
banker says, "are the extraordinary
expansion of earnings and the fast-
rising values of land. It is apparent
to those who hold a reasonably good
acquaintance with the vast scale upon
which Canadian Pacific operates, that
in a comparatively short time \$100,000,
100 or more of new cash capital must
be provided. When the time comes,
some of this will be raised, no doubt,
thru the issuance and sale of new 4
per cent. debenture, which will proba-
bly be about \$20,000,000. The balance
of the \$80,000,000, he estimates, will
be obtained by issuing additional
common stock."

Issuance and sale of an additional

amount of common stock is only a mat-
ter of time. An issue amounting to
perhaps 10 per cent. of the present
amount outstanding may be looked for
with reasonable assurance before the
lapse of another year. The \$18,000,000
new stock, now being paid for, will
have yielded \$21,000,000 by the time it
is paid up in October. "Another offer-
ing of say, \$40,000,000, at 150, which
was the price of the \$18,000,000 issue
of last year, would yield \$60,000,000,
but as there is a likelihood of the
next block being offered at a higher
price, probably 165, an issue of "16-
000,000 would bring \$66,000,000. Such
an amount would serve to carry the
company's program forward on an in-
creased basis for another year.

Canadian Pacific is by no means
pressed for cash. The explanation for
this constant requirement of addition-
al money is the fact that the man-
agement continually enlarges its pro-
gram and discovers more facilities
that need to be provided. The com-
pany ordinarily has on hand a work-
ing cash balance of \$45,000,000 to \$50,
000,000, and this amount coupled with
the new capital, will enable the com-
pany to carry out its program of ex-
tensive expansion of its railway and
thru sale of common stock and about
\$1,000,000 of preferred stock in London
at the close of last year—the company
could put about \$20,000,000 into the
construction work it has under way
without issuing any new stock.

But just as Canadian Pacific is
planning several years ahead all the
time with regard to enlarging its
freight and passenger transportation
plant and its various adjuncts, and
securing a time when the vast
territory it is situated in, so it must
continually provide generous amounts
of new capital to properly operate
that it already has. Hence the reason-
ableness of expecting a new stock
issue to the extent of about \$50,000,000
with new authorization of perhaps
\$150,000,000.

Chartered Accountants Meet

The 35th annual meeting of the In-
stitute of Chartered Accountants of
Ontario was held at Niagara-on-the-
Lake on Saturday, and was well at-
tended.

The president's address reviewed ex-
tensively the work of the past year,
and showed that much important pro-
gress had been made. It will be printed
for distribution.

The report of the membership com-
mittee was presented by Mr. George
Edwards, and the view of the account-
ants appeared that the degree of F.
C. A. was an honor to be conferred
upon members who had rendered con-
spicuous service to the institute, or had
acquired a high reputation for charac-
ter and skill in the practice of their
profession.

The report of the education com-
mittee, presented by John I. Sutcliffe,
and the debate upon it, showed the growing
importance of technical education, in
view of the rapid advance of com-
petency and the demand for instruction
in the higher branches of accountancy.
The matter was referred to the
incoming council for special consideration.

The report of the representative on
the council of the Dominion Association
of Chartered Accountants, was pre-
sented by George U. Stitt, and re-
lated attention to the report, which
would appear in the July number of
The Canadian Chartered Accountant,
on "Uniformity of Standards," setting
forth the standards recommended for
adoption by all the Canadian account-
ant societies. Committees were ap-
pointed to assist at the annual meet-
ings of the Association, to be held in
Toronto on Sept. 24 and 25.

The election of officers resulted as

appointed delegates to the annual con-
ference of the American Association of

Shaver and F. D. Burpee.
