4. Halt-Action rear-W. h drill cartridge, load-Fire one round (friction tube to be used).

5. Cease firing—Front limber up—Form the order of march.

The pace throughout is not to exceed a trot.

The side gates will be 30 yards from the starting point and from each other.

No. 1's horse may be held by No. 7 when the gun is in action. No. 1 will lead through the gates.

Drill cartridges to be taken separately from the limber box by No. 6.

Ammunition not to be carried.

For striking any of the pickets, 5 seconds to be added to the total time.

For any faults or mistakes in drill as judged by Umpire, not more than 5 seconds to be added for each.

Umpire's decision to be final. No appeal.
