

NINTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
CONVALESCENT HOME,
MURRAY * BAY.

In submitting to our friends the ninth annual report of the MURRAY BAY CONVALESCENT HOME we have again with feelings of gratitude to thank Our Heavenly Father for the measure of success that has attended this work.

The number of inmates during the season has been 36 adults and 14 children, most of whom have greatly benefited by their residence in the Home.

MISS HERVEY, the foundress of this Institution, and under whose management it has been carried on for the last nine years, finding her health failing and the work increasing so largely as to render it impossible for one person to conduct it efficiently, and wishing to place the Institution on a more permanent basis, decided to request the co-operation of those interested in the Home. A notice was given in the Murray Bay Protestant Church of a meeting to be held at the Home on Monday, the sixth of August: a number of friends responded to this call, and after some kindly discussion a new constitution was drawn up and adopted, as follows:

- (1.) The MURRAY BAY CONVALESCENT HOME shall be under the control of a committee of eight ladies, to be chosen annually at a meeting of those attending the Murray Bay Protestant Church, to be held in the month of July, who shall be called the Committee of Management.
- (2.) Public notice of the annual meeting shall be given at each service in the Protestant Church, the Sunday preceding such meeting.
- (3.) The Committee shall hold office until their successors are appointed.
- (4.) In case of death, resignation or removal by any cause of any member between the annual meetings the remaining members shall fill such vacancy or vacancies.
